1:1 Class	4	Listening/Speaking /Reading/Grammar	One-on-one intensive sessions to strengthen the four key English skills: listening, speaking, reading, and grammar. This extends to vocabulary, sentence structures, thematic speaking, and thematic writing practices. The use of leveled materials allows for adaptive learning, effectively reinforcing learning outcomes.
Group Class	1	English writing	Through 1:4 small group classes, the efficiency of learning "writing" skills is enhanced. Topics are selected from everyday life, with writing practice progressing from basic to advanced levels, applying learned grammar.
	3	Public Speaking Classes/Activity Classes	Public speaking classes help children build confidence and practice various skills in front of their peers. Activity classes offer engaging themes and interactive experiences, such as cultural lessons, allowing children to explore diverse content, foster learning interests, and practice application.

1:1 Class	2	Listening/ Speaking	The Guardian program focuses on listening and speaking skills, offering a relaxed learning experience for accompanying guardians. It also strengthens the most useful English skills while immersing them in a English environment!
Optional Class	1	Conversational English/ English Vocabulary/ English Pronunciation/ Culture Exchange	Mainly covers practical English skills, addressing common weaknesses such as vocabulary, conversation, and pronunciation, and incorporates these into practical or everyday themes for learning.
	1	Singing/ Fitness Class/ English Pronunciation/ Zumba/ English Game	Consists mostly of activity-based classes, extending learning through leisure activities. It allows students to relax both body and mind while applying English in real-life situations.
